Golf Cart Rules & Regulations

For the safety of all Stonegate Owners and Guests, the Board of Directors has implemented the following rules and regulations regarding the operation of golf carts in the Stonegate Community.

- **Minimum Age-** Golf Carts are not to be operated by anyone under the age of 12 years.
- **Occupancy-** no more than two people per bench seat are to be on a golf cart in motion.
- **Standing-** there is to be no standing on a golf cart while in motion.
- **Lights-** All Golf Carts must have working lights.
- **Operation of Golf Carts-** there are to be no games played involving other golf carts including but not limited to chicken, or bumper carts, racing, etc.
- **Sidewalks-** Golf Carts are not to be operated on sidewalks, around the pool area, basketball court or tennis court. The only exceptions are the sidewalks by the entrance ponds. When operating on the sidewalks at the entrance, Golf Carts are to give pedestrians the extreme right-of-way.
- **Private Property-** Golf Carts are not to be driven on private property other than your own without the owner's permission.
- **Stonegate Entrance-** all golf carts are forbidden to drive thru the shrubbery, hedges and the grass lawn in the front of Stone Gate.

There are no vehicles allowed, motorized or not, on sidewalks around the pool. This includes Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards etc.

Any Parents allowing children to operate Golf Carts do so at their own risk and peril and will hold harmless the Property Owners Association and the Board of Directors from any and all liability of any kind or character directly or indirectly associated with such operation. Golf Carts are not
